Ronda Owens called the meeting to order at 2:00 P.M. Board members present were Gena Jones, Zyzic Owens, Ronda Owens and Molly Ryan, Ex-Officio.

Call to the Public: None

Ronda Owens made a motion to approve July 14, 2011 board minutes. Zyzick Owens seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Molly Ryan presented her report to the Board. Ms. Ryan reported that the school is doing well. On September 15th we had our Indian Day Festival and invited parents to come out and participate. On October 6th and 7th we had Parent Teacher Conferences. We had 69 families who attended the conferences. This was the largest turnout that we have had. On Thursday evening after the conferences ended, we had an IEP Curriculum Night. Parents that attended were given surveys to complete and were also treated to pizza, cookies and drinks. Mr. Rogers's social studies classes were treated to a civil war re-enactment. A great article was published in the Gila River News Paper about the re-enactment. Block two began on October 17, 2011. We started our 7th and 8th grade honors math and honors language arts classes this block. District 3 Councilman, Dale Enos made a visit to the school. He was very impressed with the school. He had a good visit with the staff and students. Mr. Dolfo put together a PowerPoint for the Education Standing Committee meeting and the District 5 Community Council meeting. He did a great job. There are 11 students who are attending tutoring classes with Ms. Groff from 2:30 to 3:30 on Thursdays.

Ms. Owens welcomed Mr. Rudy Dolfo to the board meeting. Mr. Dolfo has an extensive background in education.

Ms. Owens made a motion to accept Rudy Dolfo as a Board Member to Skyline Gila River School Board. Gena Jones seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Ms. Owens made a motion that new board member, Rudy Dolfo step into the position of School Board President for Gila River LLC. Gena Jones seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Newly elected Board President, Rudy Dolfo gave his report on his meeting with the Vah-Ki School Board. Mr. Dolfo said that the Vah-Ki Board wants to work with us. They want us here. We will have a lease agreement with Vah-Ki for another two years. Mr. Dolfo said that there were complaints being made about the restroom that the Vah-Ki Board occupies. Ms. Ryan stated that we do not lease that building so we are not responsible for the cleaning. If they would like to include the building with the lease agreement, then we will maintain those restrooms.

Ms. Owens made a motion to have Rudy Dolfo and Swen Andersen put the Lease Agreement Contract together that will include the bathroom and maintenance. Gena Jones seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Dolfo made a motion to table discussion and consideration of Policies for Gym and School Rentals. Ms. Owens seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Ms. Owens introduced Mr. Carl Hill as the new Superintendent of Skyline Gila River.

Mr. Dolfo made a motion to adjourn meeting. Ms. Owens seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 2:25 P.M.
