



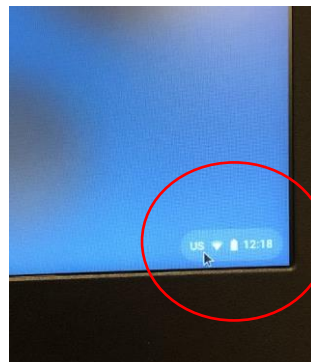
Accessing your Chromebook

STEP 1



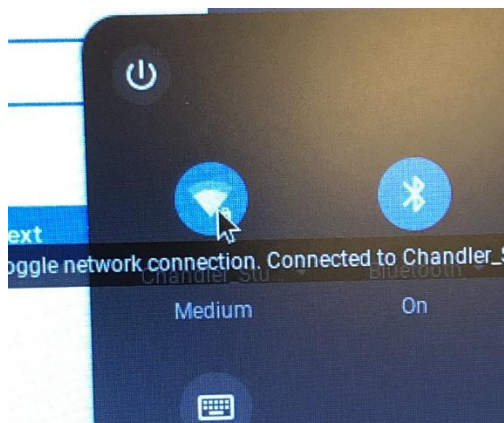
1. Look in the bottom corner of your laptop

STEP 2



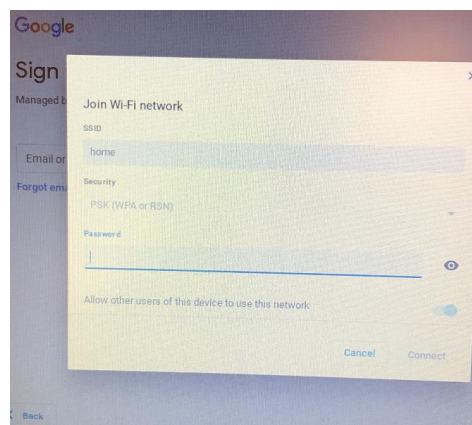
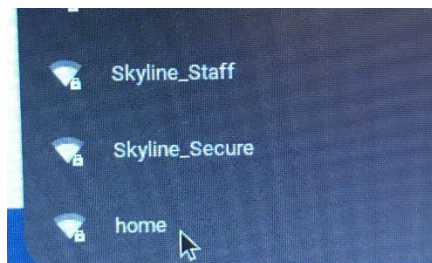
2. Connect to your home wireless. Start by selecting the menu bar in the lower right-hand corner

STEP 3



Select the arrow next to the wifi symbol to select your home wireless. If you accidentally click the wifi symbol instead of the arrow, this will turn off your wireless access.

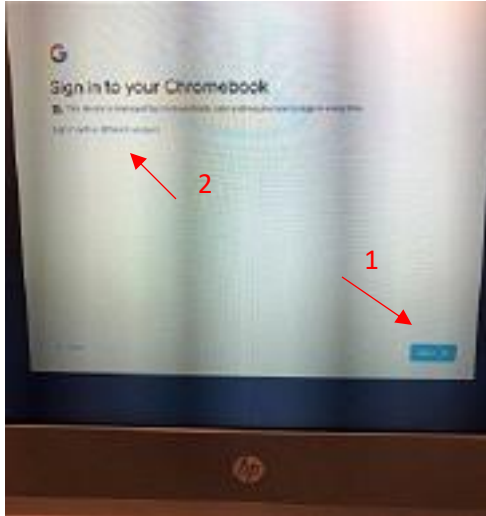
STEP 4



4. Clicking the arrow will give you a dropdown menu to select your home wireless. Find your wireless, select it, and put in your password to connect to it.



STEP 5



5. Once connected to wireless, you will be taken to a sign in page. Signing in now comes in two options.

Option 1 is to use your QR code badge that was handed out with your Chromebook. This will save you the most time.

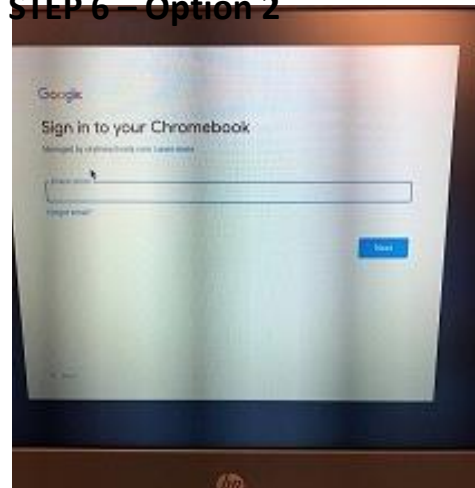
Option 2 is by using your student email and password. You will only want to use this method if your QR badge is not working.

STEP 6 – Option 1



6. Option 1: Select next on the sign in page, and it will turn on your Chromebook camera. Once your camera is on, hold your card up and it will sign you in. For older students, it will ask for a pin number. This number is the last 6 digits of your student password (your birthdate). This will sign you into your clever account automatically, which will give you access to all your online resources.

STEP 6 – Option 2



7. Option 2: Select “Sign in with a different account.” from the sign in page. This will take you to a location to enter your student email and password.

Enter your email and password and it will sign you into the Chromebook. Once signed in, the clever sign-in page will pop up automatically. You will need to select google sign in and sign into this with your email and password again. Then, you will be taken to your online resources.
